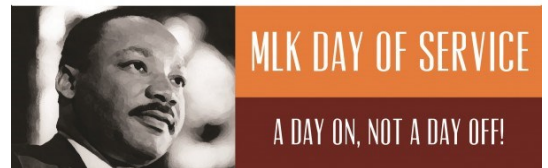
MARTIN LUTHER KING JR DAY OF SERVICE OBSERVED

Taking place each year on the third Monday in January, the MLK Day of Service is the only federal holiday observed as a national day of service – a "day on, not a day off".

After a long struggle, legislation was signed in 1983 creating a federal holiday marking the birthday of Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. In 1994, Congress designated the Martin Luther King Jr. Federal Holiday as a national day of service.

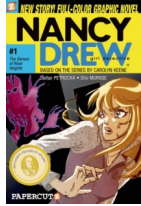
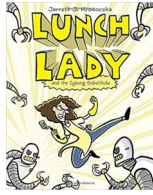
- Received Ph.D. by the age of 22
- At 26 years old, led boycott of segregated Montgomery buses which gains national attention
- In 1963, he delivers "I Have A

- In 1964, Congress passed Civil Rights Act of 1964
- Youngest person to receive Nobel Peace Prize in 1964
- Voting Rights Act of 1965 passed
- April 4, 1968, Dr. King was shot and killed while visiting Memphis in support of striking black garbage collectors.

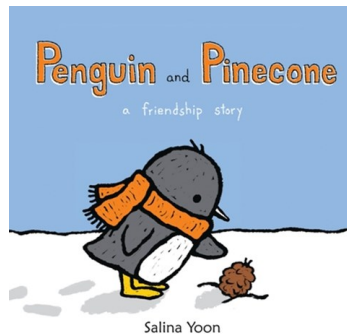
